Policies

- Policies are established by the Ministry of Higher Education
- The rules and regulations are in accordance with the policies established by the parent ministry and are customized according to the governing board of each university.
- A revision of the law 01.00 in general and the research part in particular is underway
- A new joint decision on financial management procedures in universities between the Ministry of Economy and Finance and the Department of Higher Education and Scientific Research wil be signed in January 2016.
